Ross appeared on the **5AD** Saturday morning country program hosted by **Bob Fricker** and also **5KA's Bobby's Community Sing Along.** 


In 1957 Ross joined a country band called 'The South Aussie Ramblers'

Ross's first big break came when Rocky Page invited Ross to sing on the 5RM "Sunset Trail Shows", which was recorded live in the 1950's and 60's. Ross then appeared on stage in Rocky's charity shows with many top Australian artists in country towns around South Australia and Victoria.

Ross married and hung up his guitar for 18 years while the children grew up, but with encouragement from family and friends he took up country music again and created his "Gummy Bill" act which has been very successful.
