Ma's Tip On The Best Lemonade Ever

'Lemon Tree very pretty....' But what do you do with all those lemons?

Prep Time: 30 Minutes Cook Time: 5 Minutes Ready In: 4 Hours Servings: 12

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 3/4 cups white sugar
- 8 cups water
- 1 1/2 cups of fresh lemon juice

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small saucepan, combine sugar and 1 cup water. Bring to boil and stir to dissolve sugar. Allow to cool to room temperature, then cover and refrigerate until chilled.
- 2. Remove seeds from lemon juice, but leave pulp. In pitcher, stir together chilled syrup, lemon juice and remaining 7 cups water.

Now you know what to do with those left over lemons.
