Don't just stand there – move! Use the stage and take your mike off the stand to make sure you are performing to both sides of the room – of course if you a playing an instrument, this is impossible, so invest in a clip on remote mike (or whatever you call it) and go for it. A few dance steps or simply stepping out the length of the stage will make your act more interesting and don't forget to look at your audience and smile – no 'pan' faces keep your face animated at all times whether it be sad for a sad song or cheeky or outrageous....

Don't forget to acknowledge your backing band by names if you can or at least mention their Band name and ask for a hand for the group – don't overlook the backup vocalists, sound men, lighting guys, management etc. Thank the audience for their part in your performance and for being there, leave them with a well wish of your choice i.e. safe journey, come back again, say hello to your dog for me (I'm being silly now) etc.

Whatever you do, be yourself and create your own type of performance and not someone else's.

I wish you well and after reading this, take a little of what might suit you or do your own thing – I have made a career of doing just that and have loved every minute of it **so good luck and I'll be watching** out for all you fabulous new artists as I slowly fade into the past. WHAT A LIFE!
