



Young in years and yet mature in experience **Tanya** Cornish and Georgette Berry each deserve recognition for their effort and for their performances supporting **Country Music**.

Both talented singer/musician/songwriters are on stage regularly as semi professionals, and yet still take time out to support others by performing free of charge.

Tanya Cornish grew up on her family's beef cattle property in the upper south east of South Australia. She's been interested in music and singing from an early age and has performed at many concerts and events.

Throughout her schooling, Tanya learned piano and guitar and took voice lessons. She completed years 10, 11 and 12 at Annesley College in Adelaide, where she gained high achievements for her year 12 solo and ensemble performances.

In 2011 Tanya placed many firsts in talent quests at various country music festivals around South Australia, including Port Pirie, Gawler, Mt. Gambier and Laura, and she recently won second place to Kym Wilson in the Senior Female Vocalist South Australian Champion of Champions.

Early in 2012 Tanya travelled to **Tamworth** for the country music festival where she represented the state in the **South** Australian Country Music Showcase.

Georgette Berry began singing at school in Berri as part of the year 5 school choir. Her first public singing performance was in 2005 at a Berri Lions Club dinner, and as a result Georgette was invited to perform at the Renmark Carols by Candlelight.

In 2006 encouraged by family and friends Georgette decided to exhibit her musical talents to a wider audience by entering a number of country music talent quests including Mildura, Port Pirie, Port Augusta, Tailem Bend and Barmera, and has since performed at each of these festivals annually.
