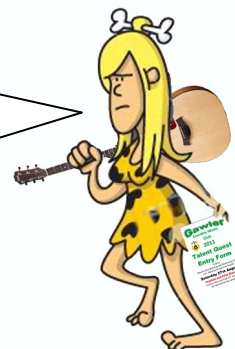

Dads Sponge Cake

4 Eggs separated
¾ cup Castor Sugar
¾ cups Cornflour
1 tblsp Custard Powder
1 tsp Cream of Tartar
½ tsp Bicarb Soda



Separate the eggs, beat the egg whites until stiff, not dry, add sugar then beat egg yolks. Sift all dry ingredients together then fold in lightly. Put into sponge tin (round) that has been buttered or lined with baking paper. Bake for 25 mins at 190-200c.

Yvonne's Winter Night Recipe.

Chicken and Bacon Casserole

1 tblsp of Olive Oil
750 g Chicken Thigh Fillets cut into 3cm cubes
1 Leek White part only thinly sliced
150g Diced Bacon Rashers
1 cup Chicken Stock
1 tblsp of Seeded Mustard
1 tblsp of Cornflower blended with half a cup of cream



Heat olive oil in a large based pan over high heat Add chicken and cook until browned. Remove chicken and reduce pan to medium heat Add leek and bacon stirring for 5 to 6 minutes Add chicken, stock and seeded mustard. Bring to boil then reduce heat to low and simmer for 15 minutes Stir in cornflower mixture and bring to boil Cook until sauce thickens and season with freshly ground black pepper. Serve with mashed potato and seasonal greens.

I Remember Who?



Frank Ifield learned to yodel listening to Hank Snow records in his youth in Australia, and then put it to good use later on with a string of hits including his biggest, "I Remember You", which topped the charts in Australia the UK and went to #5 in September of 1962 in the U.S. The song itself was composed by Victor Schertzinger with lyrics by Johnny Mercer and introduced in the 1942 film, "The Fleet's In", where it was first sung by Dorothy Lamour backed by the Jimmy Dorsey Orchestra. Johnny Mercer wrote the lyrics for the "love of his life", Judy Garland, and gave her the song the day after she married David Rose.
